- Share any news with the community











TIP: You can draw the attention of specific attendees to a channel or message by tagging them with a @

e.g. "@JohnWarbler- This conference is great!"

- ★ #conference-helpdesk use this to speak directly to the conference organisers for technical support or questions about how the conference will run (we will respond as soon as possible)
- ★ #general-chat use this channel for open communication and discussion with all attendees signed into Slack during the conference.
- #jobs-collaboration-opportunities do you have an open position? Are you looking for collaborators for a project, or are you looking for new job opportunities? Use this channel to share anything related to the conference theme.
- ★ #posters list of posters sorted according to programme. Use "Reply in thread" to ask presenters any questions.
- #sX-... use these channels to find answers to unanswered questions for a given talk or use them to ask questions after each session

#### Open new "topic\_..." channels

#topic\_... – these are channels where specific topics can be discussed. All attendees can set up their own topic channels, but please start the name of the channel with this prefix.
