Zoom

Slack - ePosters

- We will use Slack to share e-posters and host virtual poster sessions with Q&A.

Role of a #BOUsci24 attendee

Of course, we encourage questions during the Q&A sections of each talk. We also encourage you to support our poster presenters by engaging in **virtual poster sessions** over on Slack.

You are very welcome to begin posting questions within the Zoom Q&A box before the pre-recorded talk finishes. You can upvote a question by clicking the thumbs-up icon within the 'Q&A' function window. Do not post questions in the 'Chat' function.

Accessing the virtual conference via Zoom

Each attendee will receive an individual Zoom registration confirmation email from the BOU, giving you access to the conference. This will be sent to the email address that you registered with, in the days leading up to the conference. When opening the conference link, you must use the email you used to sign up for the conference.

Accessing the virtual poster session via Slack

- You will receive the Slack link in conference materials circulated in the days leading up to the conference. We suggest that you sign into the Slack workspace as soon as you receive the link to ensure that your access and profile are set up and ready to go.
